**Mad Science Experiments**—school aged kids will have fun exploring, creating and experimenting with Miss Stephanie! (aka: Mad Scientist!)



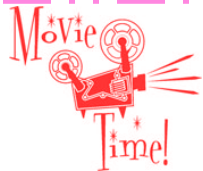
