Eligibility

Lake County Library System's Teen Video Challenge is open to residents of Florida aged 13 - 18.

Each participant (or group) may submit one video per entry form. Each entry must include signed photo authorization forms. All submissions must be received by **April 10, 2015**. Late entries will not be accepted.

Terms and Conditions

All audio and artwork must be created by the entrant or be in the public domain and must be specified as such on the entry form.

Video Criteria for Acceptance

All videos must:

- Be 30 to 90 seconds.
- Promote the idea of using public libraries and reading.
- Be designed for use at any library.
- Be appropriate for viewing by audiences of all ages.

Video will be judged on the following criteria

- Creativity
- Message clarity and relevance
- Motivation and inspiration
- Overall impact

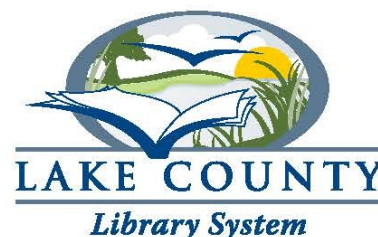
