The Lake County Library System is holding its Annual Poetry Contest in honor of April as National Poetry Month. Entries are being accepted April 1 – April 30. The contest is for all ages and will be separated into **three age groups**:

- Children: 0-12 years old
- Teens: 13-17
- Adults: 18 and up

There is a 2 poem limit per person. One form can be submitted with multiple poems.

Qualifying entries should be:

- On any topic and any style of writing
- Typed – first and last name should **NOT** be on the front of the poem
- Each poem should be on **ONE** page of 8.5 x 11 in. paper.

Submit your entries:

- **Online:** Submit your poem(s) online along with a completed entry form. (PDF or Word Files only)
- **Email:** Email your poem(s) with completed entry form to lcls-poetrycontest@mylakelibrary.org.
- **In person:** Submit your poem(s) with completed entry form at any of the 16 Lake County Library System libraries.
